

## BRC Membership Fees

Effective 1st September 2024

All membership levels include access to club facilities. The gym and indoor rowing facilities are available to all levels listed below at all times, except when booked for exclusive use by specific racing squads.

The table below shows total cost of annual membership or, if monthly or quarterly payments are preferred, the equivalent amount to pay as illustration. Only the fee in one column is to be paid.

### Payment of Fees

Paying membership monthly by Standing Order is the most efficient way of ensuring that your fees

are up to date. We welcome members who would like to pay annually or more regularly, but you must ensure that fees are paid in advance and, if fees are changed over the period, any variation is

covered.

Members who are not able to attend the club for any reason but wish to continue their membership

are still responsible for payment of fees. Membership is an annual cost that we allow members to

pay over the term to make it accessible.

While we endeavour to keep fees as low as possible, we do need to raise them occasionally to ensure that we cover the costs of running the club. We aim to do this annually to keep the

increments low and look to RPI or similar measure for the basis of the fee increase.

Please note that fees are non-refundable except by agreement of the Club at the discretion of the

committee.

##### Full Adult Member

Compete in local, national, and international regattas.

Access to all Club boats and land-based training facilities at the discretion of the Club Captain or

designated coaches and by priority according to squad timetable.

Full voting rights at all general meetings.

##### Full Junior Rowing

A rower/cox may train and compete at Junior level until 31st December of the year in which they reach the age of 18.

Compete in local, national, and international regattas.

Access to all Club boats and land-based training facilities at the discretion of the Club Captain or

designated coaches and by priority according to squad timetable.

Full voting rights at all general meetings.

##### Additional Family Member

As Full Adult or Junior, but cost reduced if an immediate family member is one of the two above levels.

Full voting rights at all general meetings.

##### Recreational Rowing

Access to all Club boats and land-based training facilities at the discretion of the Club Captain or

designated coaches and by priority according to squad timetable.

Full voting rights at all general meetings.

#### Explore+

Access to all Club boats and land-based training facilities at the discretion of the Club Captain  
or

designated coaches and by priority according to squad timetable.

#### Adaptive Rowing

Access to all Club boats and land-based training facilities at the discretion of the Club Captain  
or

designated coaches and by priority according to squad timetable.

Full voting rights at all general meetings.

#### Junior Sundays Only

A rower/cox may train and compete at Junior level until 31st December of the year in which they reach the age of 18.

Access to all Club boats and land-based training facilities at the discretion of the Club Captain  
or

designated coaches and by priority according to squad timetable.

#### Student Rowing

Access to all Club boats and land-based training facilities at the discretion of the Club Captain  
or

designated coaches and by priority according to squad timetable.

Access to facilities restricted to academic holidays

Competes in local, national, and international regattas during academic holidays.

#### Coach/Cox

One off payment.

Access to Club boats and land-based training facilities to support crews and squads being coxed or

coached.

Access to all Club boats and land-based training facilities at the discretion of the Club Captain  
or

designated coaches and by priority according to squad timetable.

Full voting rights at all general meetings.

#### Racking

Storage of private 1x/2/2x.

Storage of private boats requires full membership to be paid. Interest in obtaining a rack must go through the Club Captain as space is limited.
